These are the same books as we have in school.</p> <p>If you go onto the Amazon website (not the app) and search for Biff, Chip, Kipper free books and purchase them for £0.00 (kindle edition) they will be sent to your kindle app. We have done this with titles including – ‘Funny fish’, ‘Dad’s birthday’, ‘A good trick’, ‘Floppy did this’ and ‘Lets recycle’. Once upon a picture




We all wish we had a flying house that could take us anywhere we liked but what if it was true. Answer the questions below and it might prompt you to write a little story...
