


Reading	Phonics	Spelling					
<p>Reading books teaches children many valuable skills such as how to handle a book correctly. However we know it can be difficult to motivate them to read so maybe try reading on an electronic device instead.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oxford Owls have free reading 'e-books'. There are currently lots of Biff, Chip and Kipper free stories on the kindle app that you can then read through your devices. <p>You could also write words from the books, especially the tricky words (phase 3 tricky words mat on the resources section of the website) onto flashcards and put them around the house or garden to read as they find them – it's still reading – just more fun!</p>	<p>Mrs Wellum's group: Keep practising your Phase 5 sounds using your Phase 5 word mat (on the school website) This week can you focus on the alternative pronunciations of 'ch': firstly as in 'chip' then as in 'machine' then as in 'school'. This is a tricky one to get their heads around!</p> <p>Mrs Lenton's group: Can you play a game of sentence substitution by writing this sentence then changing one word to make it into a different one... Fred has spent lots of cash this year. Gretel/ lost/ lent/ bricks.</p> <p>Mrs Askwith's group: Practise your Phase 3 sounds (phase 3 mat on the school website). This week can you focus on 'oa', 'ar', and 'or'. 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<p>Writing (including Punctuation & Grammar)</p> <p>Now you know the story of 'The town mouse and the country mouse' can you retell it? 
