Can you keep up with the reader on the video? Can you add expression? (we say 'giraffe' a bit differently to the reader on the video!)</p> <p><b>Complete the reading comprehension activity (there are different Yr 1 and Yr 2 ones in the files.)</b></p> <p>Suggested other activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Act out scenes from the story, using clothes as props.</li> <li>Play 'True or false' with an adult/brother/sister. Say a sentence about the story and your partner has to decide if it is true or false. Follow the steps below.             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make a plan (using pictures or key words) to remind you which animal is saying thank you for what item.</li> <li>Turn each key word pair/picture pair into a sentence for your letter. Can you include adjectives to describe the animal or clothing?</li> <li>Check your letter starts 'Dear George' and ends with 'Love from...'</li> <li>Can you use the conjunctions 'and', 'but' or 'because' (or others) to join two ideas?</li> </ol> </li> </ul>	<p>Year 1            Look at the assessment page.
