<p>Read for at least 20 minutes every day. You don't just have to read fiction books, you can also find something else. Complete the SPaG Mat (Summer Term 2, Mat 5)</p> <p><u>Maisie and the Dragon</u> Watch and read along https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uwQCQ1V_ZWM&feature=youtu.be</p> <p>Have a go at the daily activities. The first two days are about a dragon story. If you want to stick with the dragon theme all week, here are some ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw your own dragon • Label all the nouns (e.g eyes, teeth, scales) • Add an adjective (or two) to each noun (e.g <u>beady</u> eyes, <u>sharp dangerous</u> teeth, <u>shiny</u> scales). • Use your picture to write sentences about your dragon e,g The dragon had beady eyes to search for its prey. • You could even make it into a poem: Beady eyes for looking, Sharp dangerous teeth for crunching bones etc • Draw a map showing all the places Maisie goes in the story. <p>If you want to move on to Day 3 and 4, it is based on a story called 'Dogger'. Try the suggested activities.</p>	<p>Year 1 Keep working on the Year 1 Common exception words if you need to. If you can spell them all, start to look at the Year 2 list (lists in previous weeks) Look at the Phonics Phase 5 Powerpoint in our resources file.</p> <p>Year 2 (Mrs Senior's group) Words with the suffix 'less'. These are your words for this week. careless painless hopeless mindless fearless lifeless</p> <p>See the Powerpoints above and below for some phonics practise.</p> <p>Year 2 (Miss Edward's group) Keep working your way through the checking of the Year 2 spellings. If you can do this, start to work on the Year 3 / 4 list (see previous resources).</p> <p>Look at the Powerpoint and activities for Phase 6 in the resources folder.</p>
