<p>Read for at least 20 minutes every day. You don't just have to read fiction books, you can also find something else. It could be a magazine, newspaper, website, game instructions or even some recipes.</p> <p>60 second read: Fred's New Friend</p> <p><u>George and the Dragon</u> Watch this video of the author reading the book. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=HSI3wpySr5Q</p> <p>Read along with this version. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3Dejq-XAOY4 See the accompanying daily suggested activities. See if you can read along</p>	<p>There are more games set on Education City (Summer Term English). Complete the SPaG Mat (Summer Term 2, Mat 6) <u>George and the Dragon</u> Watch and read along. Re-read it each day, with increasing fluency/expression. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3Dejq-XAOY4</p> <p>Have a go at the daily activities (see resources for ideas for each day). Monday and Tuesday: Reading comprehension tasks Wednesday: Describe the dragon Thursday and Friday: Retell the story.</p> <p>Other ideas: Can you draw and describe your own dragon? Can you make a model of a dragon? Find other stories about dragons. Can you write your very own story about a dragon? What might your dragon be scared of? Would you like a dragon as a pet? What might your pet dragon do?</p>	<p>Year 1 Keep working on the Year 1 Common exception words if you need to. If you can spell them all, start to look at the Year 2 list (lists in previous weeks) Look at the Phonics Phase 5 Powerpoint in the previous resources file. Year 2 (Mrs Senior's group) Words with the suffix 'en'. These are your words for this week. flat flatten soft soften tight tighten loose loosen</p> <p>See the Powerpoints above and below for some phonics practise.</p> <p>Year 2 (Miss Edward's group) Keep working your way through the checking of the Year 2 spellings.
