Imagine that he goes out and meets someone else. Who might he meet? What might they tell him about the dark? They might say that 'Dark is.....' Have a look at the planning sheet (3 slightly different versions if you are printing or just use the ideas) I think if I was writing it, I might say that 'Dark is great' then go on to tell plop about reading bedtime stories snuggled up and remind him of all the things you can do in the dark. Have a go...remember, the last chapter really needs to try to persuade Plop <u>not</u> to be afraid of the dark!
