Making Choices

Our staff build in opportunities for the children make choices through the curriculum and their general approaches to working



with our pupils. Children have opportunities to make choices about their work, their clubs and activities, their lunch, how their classroom is organised, rewards that have been earned over time. We use class discussions, votes, School Council, surveys and questionnaires.

Throughout their time at this school, pupils are given a voice and we aim that every child will feel that there is someone in school that they can talk to in times of need. Part of our approach to behaviour is that children, especially those with SEND issues, are able to make choices about how they interact with others and about their life in this school.
