




# Nursery Home Learning

<p><b>Book of the week</b>-Try and keep reading the same book throughout the week but think of different things each time you read it.</p> <p><i>Day 1:</i> Read the story.</p> <p><i>Day 2:</i> Tell the story using the pictures and not the words.</p> <p><i>Day 3:</i> Take turns with your child describing the pictures-what the characters look like, where they are and what is happening to them?</p> <p><i>Day 4:</i> Could you draw a picture of your favourite character?</p> <p><i>Day 5:</i> Think up an alternative ending to the story and re-read it using this</p> <p><b>Discussion time</b></p> <p>This week we are talking about <b>YOU!!!</b> What makes you special? What makes you unique? Have a look at the 'We Are All Unique' resource and then talk with your family. I could tell you lots of different reasons why each of you are special and unique. Could you put on Tapestry or email me your answers? I would love to hear your opinions. Could you draw a picture of yourself and ask a grownup to write on what you say?</p> 	<p><b>Ordering numerals.</b> Can you use the summer themed sheet and look at the numbers on each picture to decide the order they should go in the grid. Start with 1 and finish with 10.</p> <p>Why not try this game on your tablet or computer. Being creative is fun and recycling is great for helping our environment...so why not make some instruments from recycled materials. Have a look at the resource sheets and try making a shaker, drum or/and guitar.</p> 	<p><b>Name writing</b>-Being able to write your name is so, so important. When you paint a picture you can then make sure everyone knows you created it. You can show on the name board the days you are at nursery and, when you send a birthday card to a friend, they know who it is from.</p> <p>If you find writing your first name easy can you try your last and middle names? Can you write it on paper, in the air, paint it and draw it in mud? How else could you write it?</p> <p><b>Phonics</b></p> <p><b>I Spy.</b> Recently we have learnt some letter sounds. In our resources section there is a sheet for you to have a go finding pictures that start with the 's', 'a', 't', 'p', 'i', 'n' sounds. Once finished, if your grown up says one of the letter sounds can you find something around the house?</p> <p><b>Catch.</b> Before throwing a ball, say one of the above letter sounds. Then throw and whoever catches the ball has to think of something to say that starts with that sound.</p>
	<p><b>Other Topic</b></p> <p><b>Senses scavenger hunt.</b> Using the checklist see if you can explore when out on a walk or when at home. Can you find any other things in addition to what's on the list?</p>
