


# Nursery Home Learning

<p>Have a look for letters and writing around your house...</p> <p>Do you recognise any of the letters you see? Can you see any letters that are the same as the ones in your name?</p> <p>What do you think the letters and writing are for? What do they tell us?</p> <p>Can you spot any writing when out on a walk around your neighbourhood?</p> <p>Can you have a go at copying any of the writing?</p>	<p>Active animal counting: Can you beat your chest like a gorilla, jump like a kangaroo, stomp like an elephant, snap your hands like a crocodile?</p> <p>Draw pictures of the animals and make some number cards. Have 2 piles. First choose from the number pile and then the animal ones. Have a go at doing the set amount of actions.</p> 	<p>What about trying out a 'Penny Walk/Jog'...</p> <p>Decide if heads or tails means left or right.</p> <p>Every time you get to a junction or stop, flip the penny and let it decide which way to go.</p> <p>Each time you stop try to notice something different around you. What can you hear, see, smell?</p>

<p>Tell someone about your favourite storybook.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is it called?</li> <li>• What do you like about it?</li> <li>• How does it start?</li> <li>• Who was in it?</li> <li>• Who is your favourite character and why?</li> <li>• What was your favourite part and why?</li> <li>• How did it end?</li> </ul>  <p>Do you have any books that you haven't read in a while or that you have never read before? Could you look at this and then answer the above questions about this story?</p>	<p>Massage: Put on some relaxing music and take a few breaths. Maybe try practising the strokes together on cushions first and then have a go on each other.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eye glasses-Make 3 circles around the shoulder blades. Stroke out to the arms and hold.</li> <li>• Baker-Place the hands on shoulders and make gentle movements with the palm and fingers.</li> <li>• Hairdressers-Place fingers on top of hair, and make circles with the fingertips</li> </ul>	<p>The letter 's'. Can you draw it with a stick in some mud/sand? Maybe try painting it or write it with your fingers in shaving foam. What can you find or think of that starts with the letter sound?</p> <p><b>Other Topic</b></p>  <p>Bumblebees</p> <p>Can you use google to find out some facts about Bumblebees?</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of one and have your grownups label the body parts?</p>
