**Spring 1—China**

Here are the home learning activities for this half term.

Please work through these new activities with your child choosing tasks they are particularly interested in, you can complete some of the tasks or all of them!

Please can all home learning tasks for this half term be returned to school by **Monday 12th February 2018.**

**Literacy tasks**

- Find out and write about 5 or more facts about China.
- Draw or write a postcard from China. What things have you seen? Don't forget to write who it is to and from and the address.
- Draw or write about the story of the Magic Paintbrush. What would you do if you had a magic paintbrush that made anything come to life that you painted!
- Write an acrostic poem for your name. Each letter could just be one word or a few—give it a try.

**Maths tasks**

- Play a game of hide and seek with a toy. Can you use positional language such as 'on top of', 'underneath', 'behind' and 'in front of' to describe where your toy was hiding?
- How many addition number sentences can you make with these numbers? 1, 5, 8, 10
- Can you practise counting in 2s? Can you write down how high you can count to?
- Play the Chinese New Year board game with your family (attached) if you need to borrow a dice from school just ask.

**Creative tasks**

- Research which animal of the Chinese zodiac you were born in. Make a model of your animal.
- Chinese New Year is a big celebration in China. Dragons play a big part in the celebration. Can you make a Chinese dragon?
- Can you cook some Chinese food (or even treat yourselves to a Chinese takeaway?) take lots of pictures and label what you eat.

Have fun and we can't wait to see what work you produce! If you have made your models before the end of half term please bring them in we would love to display them in the classroom.
