READING IS A CATALYST

Reading for pleasure is associated with higher levels of literacy achievement. There is also a relationship between cognition and motivation, proficiency and motivation in reading. Those who are good at reading do more of it: they learn more and expand their vocabulary and knowledge. This enables them to understand more of what they read. For those who read less, or who find reading difficult, the opposite is true. Reading more makes children more academically able.



Reading:

We are often asked by parents what they can be doing to support their children at home. Without doubt, the single most important thing you can do is **READING**. Listen to them read, read to them, visit the library, talk about books and set a good example by reading yourself. The ability to read fluently underpins all learning and gives your child the best possible chance of success. We will therefore be having a big push on reading this year; including re-establishing 'reading buddies' for younger children... If any parents or grandparents have some spare time and would like to become a **reading volunteer**; please get in touch - we are very flexible!

Wellbeing Wall:
