#### Paying for dinners via 'Parent Pay' (through Reach More app)

We are pleased to report that the 'Single Sign On' facility is now working correctly; allowing you to access the Parent Pay part of Reach More. From here, you should be able to check your child's dinner balance\* and make payments.

\*If your child has been having dinners over the last 3 weeks, this should be showing as a negative balance. Please clear this and deposit funds for future lunches as soon as possible. If you think there has been an error, please get in touch with the school office and they will be happy to check this for you.

Meanwhile, we have been informed that school dinners are set to increase in price from next week. They will now be **£2.90 per day**; see letter from our suppliers, Taylor Shaw, for more information (sent out via Reach More).

#### Holiday fines reminder

With nice weather on the horizon, people's thoughts often turn to holidays... We have been asked by the local authority to remind parents about fines for taking holidays in term-time. The current guidance (in effect since Autumn 2024) states that unauthorised term-time leave is on a 3-year rollover (i.e. the slate isn't wiped clean at the end of the academic year). This means that fines increase for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 'offences' – even if your child has moved school.
